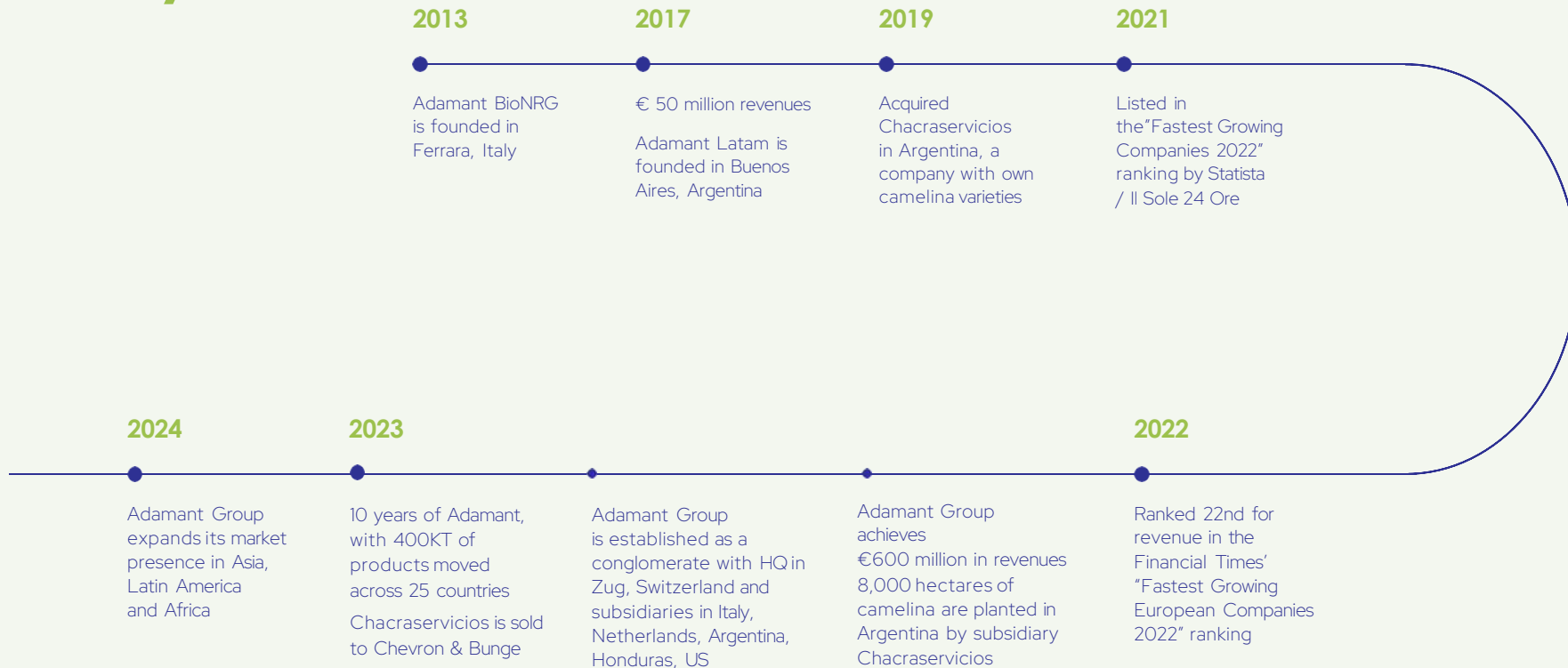
Key Achievements
